MACAU

The first ever Institute had 19 students, many coming for different modules. Three received diplomas, and 14 received certificates for modules. It was a cold LTI - for 24 straight days there was a cold weather warning. (News report said 37 elderly people died related to the cold.) Students sat in coats and gloves, and we wore many layers of clothes to keep warm. We are thankful that the students and staff stayed healthy.

Visiting staff came from Hong Kong, Taiwan and Singapore. The students went out to do open-air, teach a week of 4-Day Clubs, and also a Party Club. Praise the Lord for 110 children reached and for 57 children who received the Lord.

For six Sunday afternoons, we also held the Preschool Course. It was attended by 20 students, who went out and taught many preschoolers. Macau had now their first LTI, first preschool course, and last year the first IOT 1 Course. It has been exciting to work with Mei-Mei and the staff in Macau. God is doing great things.

INDONESIA

Indonesia also held an Institute early this year. The LTI began with ten students - all full time CEF staff. Many of the instructors were Indonesian staff who taught with excellence, along with two Korean CEF missionaries. What joy to see seven of them now ready to teach at LTI.

Five of the students said when they were interviewed that they would want to begin a new CEF branch. Thank God that as more people are trained, more children will be reached and God will be glorified in this vast Muslim land with 90 million children.

MYANMAR

One special week for the preschoolers course was held in Myanmar. Monday morning, the preschool Course began, using a Seminary's facility — a nice big room to hold 38 students. It was a very hot week, but the students did great in their assignments especially as they taught the preschoolers. The children were beautiful, and so interested in the teaching. Twenty children received the Lord. A great week indeed.

AUSTRALIA

As this is being written there is an ongoing CMI in Australia. Again it is a small class but different students are coming in for different modules. There were 11 students who attended the preschool course. One lady said, "I never believed that little ones could be saved, and that it was even important to teach them. I have had to confess my sin." God worked in so many hearts and encouraged them to be reaching the little ones. One lady is ready to begin Good News Club® in a very needy area. Praise the Lord!
